Who We Are

Shrewsbury Robotics, founded in 1999, is made up of two distinct branches: FRC Team 467 (The Shrewsbury Colonials), and the Summer Robotics Science Camp. Our team is led by students, industry engineers, parents and community members. Every year Team 467 builds a robot designed to solve the current year's FIRST Robotics Challenge. Upon completion the team competes in two district qualifying events. If we qualify we can then go to the New England District Championship and from there to the World Championship.



How We are Funded

Building robots is a costly endeavor. Our expenses include supplies to build our robot, tools, entry fees, laptops to program and control the robot, transportation to competitions and much more. While we are an extracurricular program of Shrewsbury High School we are not directly funded by the school. We depend on our fundraising and sponsorships from corporations and local businesses to continue our mission.

This year our need is greater than ever. Covid restrictions left us unable to operate our biggest fundraiser, our summer camp, for two years in a row. We were also unable to hold our annual pie bake last year. Thankfully, in 2021 our we were able to hold our pie bake.



Community Involvement

Team 467 works hard to engage the community. Donations benefit more than just our team. Every year our students visit the elementary schools in town to present a program about the engineering process and demonstrate our robot to the fourth grade students. In 2019 our students organized and ran a LEGO Robotics activity for the extended day program at Sherwood Middle School. We run our summer camp and also a "Girls Day" to promote women in STEM fields. Each year we host and run "Mindstorm Mayhem", a qualifying event for FIRST Lego Robotics. This year we will be hosting our 2nd FRC qualifying event. And each year we host a Family and Sponsor Day.

In the last two years other activities have included 3D printing pieces for face shields for health care workers, collecting money for The Worcester County Food Bank, holding a virtual blood drive through The Red Cross and donating apple pies to Veteran's Inc. in Worcester.
